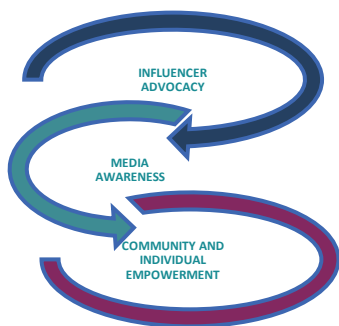




ACCOUNTANT | Terms of Reference

Ifrah Foundation is an implementing partner with UNWomen and UNFPA in Somalia, delivering programmes and activities to end Female Genital Mutilation through our Dear Daughter Campaign.

Ifrah Foundation support a combined approach to the elimination of FGM/C in the form of three pillars of action in the areas of Advocacy, Awareness and Community Empowerment.



Advocacy: Obtaining buy-in and pledges from key influencers and decision makers i.e. Political & Religious Leaders

Media Awareness: Major media initiatives intended to amplify communication on elimination of FGM and amplifying Advocacy and Community Empowerment efforts.

Community Empowerment: Engagement with

Community Organisations, education, training & health providers who reach individual practitioners, parents & guardians.

We now need to engage a **Accountant** to work closely with Ifrah Foundation to coordinate the delivery of this programme.

This role will:

- Take responsibility for Ifrah Foundation accounting and financial controls in Somalia, in close collaboration with the Executive Director and Programme Directors. Develop detailed budget to support activities and programmes planned by Ifrah Foundation.
- Oversee the disbursement and spending of all monies relating to these programmes, ensuring they are in line with Ifrah Foundation Financial Procedures and the requirements of our funders.
- Ensure all supporting documentation is kept under each spending line, including documenting of any changes to original workplans, with the prior agreement of our funders.
- Report on spending in line with agreed budgets.
- Do monthly financial reports and bank reconciliation for all work in Somalia.
- Work with our accountants and auditors in Ireland as required.

The idea candidate will:



- Have, at least, a degree in accounting and financial controls.
- Have at least 2 years' experience working NGOs and/or UN agencies.
- Have experience working on a variety of diverse actors simultaneously to achieve one shared goal.
- Be fluent in both English and Somali with strong writing skills in both languages.
- Be highly motivated with an ability to work alone and as part of a team.

The contract awardee will work within the parameters of the project as a consultant to Ifrah foundation, with direct collaboration and oversight by UNFPA Somalia and UN Women Somalia. He/she will be managed directly by the Executive Director at Ifrah Foundation. The period of this consultancy is for 5 months. This role may require travel to between Mogadishu, Kismayo and Baidoa.
